

SENATE BILL NO. 2112

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-06-03.1 and subsection 1 of
2 section 39-06-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to expiration of operator's licenses
3 and nondriver photo identification cards.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 39-06-03.1 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. The director shall issue upon request a nondriver color photo identification card to
8 any North Dakota resident who fulfills the requirements of this section. An
9 application for an identification card must be made on a form furnished by the
10 director. The application must provide for the voluntary identification of the
11 applicant as a donor under the provisions of chapter 23-06.2. If requested on the
12 identification card application, the identification card issued by the director must
13 include a statement making an anatomical gift under chapter 23-06.2. If the person
14 is under the age of eighteen or at least the age of eighteen and under the age of
15 twenty-one, the photo must be against the same color background required on a
16 motor vehicle operator's license for an operator of that age. Subject to the
17 provisions of subsection 1 of section 39-06-19, identification cards expire four
18 years from the date of issue and may be renewed.

19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 39-06-19 of the North Dakota
20 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

21 1. Every operator's license issued under this chapter expires and is renewed
22 according to this section. The expiration date of an operator's license for a person
23 whose birth occurred in a year ending in an odd numeral is twelve midnight on the
24 anniversary of the birthday in the second subsequent year ending in an odd

1 numeral. The expiration date of an operator's license for a person whose birth
2 occurred in a year ending in an even numeral is twelve midnight on the anniversary
3 of the birthday in the second subsequent year ending in an even numeral. A
4 person who has a valid, unexpired nonimmigrant visa or nonimmigrant visa status
5 for entry into the United States, a pending application for asylum in the United
6 States, a pending or approved application for temporary protected status in the
7 United States, approved deferred action status, or a pending application for
8 adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence
9 or conditional permanent residence status in the United States will be issued a
10 temporary operator's license or nondriver photo identification card. The temporary
11 operator's license or identification card is valid only during the period of time of the
12 applicant's authorized stay in the United States or, if there is no definite end to the
13 period of authorized stay, a period of one year. The license or card may be
14 renewed only upon presentation of valid documentary evidence that the status has
15 been extended.
