Currently both antlered and antlerless resident deer gun season licenses cost \$20 each. This bill adds a \$10 nonrefundable application fee for each application for an antlered deer hunting license.

In recent years about 65,000 hunters applied for antlered deer hunting licenses each year. The nonrefundable application fee will result in increase revenue for the game and fish fund of \$650,000 per year.
