1 A BILL for an Act to provide a statement of legislative intent and legislative support; and to  
2 provide a contingent appropriation to the office of management and budget for the heritage  
3 center expansion project.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - FUTURE FUNDING FOR HERITAGE CENTER**  
6 **EXPANSION.** It is the intent of the legislative assembly that the office of management and  
7 budget consider providing funding to the state historical society for the heritage center  
8 expansion project in the 2009-11 executive budget recommendation if the state historical  
9 society is able to demonstrate progress toward fundraising goals and federal funding is secured  
10 for the project. The sixty-first legislative assembly shall consider appropriating funding to the  
11 state historical society for the heritage center expansion project if the state historical society is  
12 able to demonstrate progress toward fundraising goals and federal funding is secured for the  
13 project.

14 **SECTION 2. HERITAGE CENTER EXPANSION - LEGISLATIVE SUPPORT.** The  
15 sixtieth legislative assembly supports the efforts of the state historical society in fundraising and  
16 securing federal funding for the heritage center expansion during the 2007-09 biennium.

17 **SECTION 3. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION - LANDS AND MINERALS TRUST**  
18 **FUND.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the lands and minerals trust fund the sum  
19 of \$1,500,000 on a contingency basis to the office of management and budget for the planning  
20 and design costs of the heritage center expansion project, for the biennium beginning July 1,  
21 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. The appropriation is only available when the state historical  
22 society certifies to the office of management and budget that \$1,500,000 of private funds has  
23 been received and is available for the project. The private funds must be spent before the  
24 funds from the lands and minerals trust fund.
