1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 commerce; and to provide exemptions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this
 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the department of

11 **SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 12 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 13 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 14 other income, to the department of commerce for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its 15 various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as 16 follows: 17 Salaries and wages \$8,617,235 18 13,642,636 Operating expenses 19 Capital assets 25,000 20 48,374,748 Grants

30 **SECTION 4. AGRICULTURE FUEL TAX REFUNDS.** The estimated income line item 31 in section 3 of this Act includes \$575,000 from refunds of tax for fuel used for agricultural Sixtieth Legislative Assembly

1 purposes, to be used by the agricultural products utilization commission, for the biennium

2 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

3 **SECTION 5. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated for the agricultural products 4 utilization commission in section 3 of chapter 46 of the 2005 Session Laws is not subject to 5 section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this line item for grants are available for 6 grants during the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

SECTION 6. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated for the discretionary funds line
item in section 3 of chapter 46 of the 2005 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11
and any unexpended funds from this line item are available during the biennium beginning
July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

11 SECTION 7. TAX COMMISSIONER - AUDIT OF ETHANOL PRODUCTION

12 INCENTIVE PROGRAM. The tax commissioner shall conduct an audit of the ethanol
13 production incentive program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30,
14 2009.

15 SECTION 8. DAKOTA MANUFACTURING INITIATIVE. The department of commerce 16 shall seek to contract with the Dakota manufacturing extension partnership, incorporated, to 17 implement the Dakota manufacturing initiative. The initiative includes building a membership 18 association of manufacturers in North Dakota and South Dakota, complementing existing 19 national, regional, and local manufacturing entities; providing nonduplicative services to the 20 association's manufacturing members that address critical needs, including identifying and 21 developing private procurement opportunities; and developing a consortium of major 22 manufacturers in North Dakota and South Dakota to design and support overall supply chain 23 development and supplier development. Under the initiative, state funds must be leveraged 24 with additional public and private funds, which may include federal funding sources. South 25 Dakota state funding, and funding from manufacturers.
