- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
- 2 society.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this
section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state historical society
in section 3 of this Act as follows:

9 **SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 10 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 11 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 12 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 13 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows: 14 \$7,172,657 Salaries and wages 15 2,098,911 Operating expenses 16 Capital assets 3,291,581 17 Grants 1,000,000 18 375,000 Cultural heritage grants 19 Snow angel project 10,000 20 Yellowstone-Missouri-Fort Union Commission 4,492 21 Total all funds \$13,952,641 22 Less estimated income 3,569,462

SECTION 4. REVOLVING FUND - APPROPRIATION. All fees collected by the state historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04 are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

SECTION 5. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION. All gifts,
 grants, devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society
 and deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the

3 SECTION 6. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 4 SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The total general fund appropriation line item in 5 section 3 of this Act includes \$1,883,000 for the one-time funding items identified in this 6 section. This amount is not a part of the agency's base budget to be used in preparing the 7 2009-11 executive budget. The state historical society shall report to the appropriations 8 committees of the sixty-first legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the 9 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 10 Lincoln bicentennial \$25,000

SECTION 7. COLD WAR MISSILE SITES. The capital assets line item in section 3 of this Act includes \$200,000 from the general fund, \$250,000 from federal funds, and \$200,000 from other funds available to the state historical society through fundraising efforts to acquire the missile alert facility oscar-zero located four and one-half miles north of Cooperstown, North Dakota, and the launch facility november-33 located two and one-half miles east of Cooperstown, North Dakota. The general fund moneys may only be used on a dollar-for-dollar basis as fundraising moneys become available.
