## REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2020

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state water
- 2 commission; to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-02.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to funding for Grand Forks flood control; to provide a line of credit; and to provide
- 4 an appropriation for repayment of the line of credit.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this 7 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state water

8 commission in section 3 of this Act as follows:

## SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the

- 16 base funding level for the state water commission which are included in the appropriation in
- 17 section 3 of this Act as follows:

23 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 24 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state Sixtieth Legislative Assembly

1 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 2 other income, to the state water commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 3 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows: 4 Administrative and support services \$2,456,295 5 Water and atmospheric resources 172,354,260 6 Total all funds \$174,810,555 7 Less estimated income 160,923,049 8 Total general fund appropriation \$13.887.506

9 SECTION 4. RESOURCES TRUST FUND - APPROPRIATION. The sum of 10 \$69,352,698, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income 11 line item in section 3 of this Act is from the resources trust fund and must be used by the state 12 water commission for purposes authorized by the legislative assembly, for the biennium 13 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. Any additional amount in the resources 14 trust fund that becomes available is appropriated to the state water commission for the purpose 15 of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 16 June 30, 2009.

17 SECTION 5. WATER DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND - APPROPRIATION. The sum 18 of \$40,055,999, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income 19 line item in section 3 of this Act is from the water development trust fund and must be used by 20 the state water commission for purposes authorized by the legislative assembly, for the 21 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. Any additional amount in the 22 water development trust fund that becomes available is appropriated to the state water 23 commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium 24 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

SECTION 6. GRANTS - WATER-RELATED PROJECTS - CARRYOVER
AUTHORITY. Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to funding for grants or water-related projects
included in the water and atmospheric resources line item in section 3 of this Act. However,
this exclusion is only in effect for two years after June 30, 2009. Any unexpended funds
appropriated from the resources trust fund after that period has expired must be transferred to
the resources trust fund and any unexpended funds appropriated from the water development
trust fund after that period has expired must be transferred to the water development trust fund.

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1 SECTION 7. LINE OF CREDIT - CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION. If determined 2 necessary by the state water commission, the Bank of North Dakota shall extend a line of 3 credit, not to exceed \$25,000,000, which is appropriated to the state water commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 4 5 SECTION 8. REPAYMENT OF LINE OF CREDIT - CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION. 6 If the line of credit authorized in section 7 of this Act is extended to the state water commission 7 by the Bank of North Dakota, there is appropriated out of any moneys in the water development 8 trust fund, the resources trust fund, bond proceeds, or other sources, the sum of \$25,000,000, 9 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state water commission for the purpose of 10 repaying the line of credit, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 11 **SECTION 9.** A new section to chapter 61-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 12 created and enacted as follows: 13 Grand Forks flood control project. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or 14 policy, any existing caps may not be construed to limit access to total state funding of up to fifty-two million dollars for the Grand Forks flood control project. 15
