The bill establishes a requirement for a chemigation permit and a \$30 fee per permit.

Section 1 provides for a \$30 fee for a three year permit. There are about 2,000 irrigation units which would require a permit.

The bill provides for the deposit of the fees into the Environment and Rangeland Protection Fund.

Since the Department of Agriculture doesn't have a current FTE available to absorb this increased workload, we anticipate to incur overtime (salary) expenses of \$3,600 per biennium. The Department also estimates increased operating expenses of \$3,620 to cover development of the permitting process, processing permits, and conducting outreach activities to inform chemigators of the permitting requirement.
