1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state water commission for a Beaver Bay
2 embankment feasibility study.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
5 resources trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$342,000, or
6 so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state water commission for the purpose of
7 conducting a Beaver Bay embankment feasibility study, for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The embankment feasibility study is to include a downstream
9 component and a highway embankment component.

10 **SECTION 2. BEAVER BAY EMBANKMENT FEASIBILITY STUDY - USE OF FUNDS.**

11 Of the funding provided in section 1 of this Act, no more than \$100,000 may be spent prior to
12 the acquisition of applicable licenses and authorizations from the federal army corps of
13 engineers.
