1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical

2 society.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 8 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

16 2011-13 biennium. The state historical society shall report to the appropriations committees of

17 the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium

18 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 3. REVOLVING FUND - APPROPRIATION. All fees collected by the state
historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04
are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for
the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION. All gifts,
 grants, devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society
 and deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the
 state historical society for the purposes provided in section 55-01-04, for the biennium
 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
