**SENATE BILL NO. 2016**

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of job service North  
2 Dakota; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to job service North Dakota for the purpose of defraying the expenses of job  
8 service North Dakota, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as  
9 follows:

23 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FISCAL STIMULUS FUNDS -**  
24 **ADDITIONAL FUNDING APPROVAL.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the

1 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from federal funds made available to the state  
2 under the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, not otherwise  
3 appropriated, to job service North Dakota, for the period beginning with the effective date of this  
4 Act and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

9 Job service North Dakota may seek emergency commission and budget section  
10 approval under chapter 54-16 for authority to spend any additional federal funds received under  
11 the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 in excess of the amounts  
12 appropriated in this section, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and  
13 ending June 30, 2011.

14 Any federal funds appropriated under this section are not a part of the agency's 2011-13  
15 base budget. Any program expenditures made with these funds will not be replaced with state  
16 funds after the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds are no longer  
17 available.

### 18 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - REED ACT FUNDS - UEMPLOYMENT**

19 **INSURANCE COMPUTER MODERNIZATION.** The special appropriation of \$5,515,586 in  
20 section 1 of this Act is from federal Reed Act funds made available to the state by the federal  
21 Reed Act distributions made in federal fiscal years 1957, 1958, 1999, and 2002, pursuant to  
22 section 903 of the Social Security Act. This sum, or so much of the sum as may be necessary,  
23 is for the purpose of developing a modernized unemployment insurance computer system, for  
24 the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

25 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION.** All federal funds, except funds under the federal  
26 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, received by job service North Dakota in  
27 excess of those funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are appropriated for the biennium  
28 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

29 **SECTION 5. WORKFORCE 20/20 FUNDING.** Fifty percent of the workforce 20/20  
30 funding in section 1 of this Act must be used for projects for new or expanding businesses in  
31 North Dakota.

1           **SECTION 6. EMERGENCY.** Section 2 of this Act is declared to be an emergency  
2 measure.
