- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to individual accident and health insurance coverage.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

## 6 Health insurance coverage not required.

- 7 <u>1.</u> Regardless of whether a resident of this state has or is eligible for health insurance
- 8 <u>coverage under a health insurance policy, health service contract, or evidence of</u>
- 9 <u>coverage by or through an employer or under a plan sponsored by the state or federal</u>
- 10 government, the resident is not required to obtain or maintain a policy of individual
- health coverage except as may be required by a court or by the department of human
   services through a court or administrative proceeding.
- <u>This section does not render a resident of this state liable for any penalty, assessment,</u>
   <u>fee, or fine as a result of the resident's failure to procure or obtain health insurance</u>
   <u>coverage.</u>
- 16 <u>3.</u> This section does not apply to an individual who voluntarily applies for coverage under 17 a state-administered program pursuant to the medical assistance program under title
- 18 XIX of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.] or the state's children's
- 19 <u>health insurance program under title XXI of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C.</u>
- 20 <u>1397aa et seq.]. This section does not apply to a student who is required by an</u>
- 21 institution of higher education to obtain and maintain health insurance as a condition of
- 22 enrollment. This section does not impair the rights of an individual to contract privately
- 23 for health insurance coverage for family members or former family members.
