## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1259**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 58-06-02, 58-07-01, and 58-08-01 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to compensation of township officers.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 58-06-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **58-06-02. Compensation of supervisors.**
- A township supervisor is entitled to receive as compensation for services twentyup to sixty
- 8 dollars a day for each day necessarily devoted to the work of a supervisor's office not exceeding
- 9 onetwo thousand dollars in a calendar year. The electors of the township shall establish the
- daily compensation rate for township supervisors at each annual township meeting. Additional
- 11 compensation over one two thousand dollars may be provided for reimbursement of expenses
- 12 and mileage at a rate not exceeding the allowable mileage rate accepted by the United States
- 13 internal revenue serviceas provided in section 44-08-04 and for mileage as provided in section
- 14 <u>54-06-09</u> for each mile [1.61 kilometers] necessarily traveled in the performance of a
- 15 supervisor's duties.
- 16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 58-07-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **58-07-01. Compensation of clerk.**
- The township clerk is entitled to receive as compensation for services twentyup to sixty
- 20 dollars a day for each day necessarily devoted to the work of the clerk's office not exceeding
- 21 one two thousand dollars in a calendar year. The electors of the township shall establish the
- 22 <u>daily compensation rate for the township clerk at each annual township meeting.</u> Additional
- compensation over <u>onetwo</u> thousand dollars may be provided for reimbursement of expenses
- 24 and mileage at a rate not exceeding the allowable mileage rate accepted by the United States

- 1 internal revenue serviceas provided in section 44-08-04 and for mileage as provided in section
- 2 <u>54-06-09</u> for each mile [1.61 kilometers] necessarily traveled in the performance of the clerk's
- 3 duties. In those townships in which the offices of township clerk and treasurer have been
- 4 merged, the personindividual elected to fill the new office is entitled to receive compensation as
- 5 township clerk only.
- 6 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 58-08-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **58-08-01. Compensation of treasurer.**
- 9 The township treasurer is entitled to receive as compensation for services twentysixty
- dollars a day for each day necessarily devoted to the work of the treasurer's office not
- 11 exceeding onetwo thousand dollars in a calendar year. The electors of the township shall
- 12 <u>establish the daily compensation rate for the township treasurer at each annual township</u>
- 13 <u>meeting.</u> Additional compensation over one two thousand dollars may be provided for
- 14 reimbursement of expenses and mileage at a rate not exceeding the allowable mileage rate
- 15 accepted by the United States internal revenue service as provided in section 44-08-04 and for
- 16 mileage as provided in section 54-06-09 for each mile [1.61 kilometers] necessarily traveled in
- 17 the performance of the treasurer's duties. The township treasurer may not be allowed a
- 18 percentage on the balance turned over to the treasurer's successor in office.
