1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a coyote bounty; and a statement of legislative intent.

## 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. COYOTE BOUNTY - GUIDELINES. The director shall pay a bounty of one
hundred dollars for each coyote taken after the effective date of this Act until two thousand
coyotes are taken. The director may establish guidelines for the determination and payment of
bounties under this section.
SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the legislative assembly that two

8 hundred thousand dollars of the wildlife services line item contained in section 1 of Senate Bill

9 No. 2017 be used to pay coyote bounties as authorized in section 1 of this Act. The director may

10 use up to twenty thousand dollars of the wildlife services line item contained in section 1 of

11 Senate Bill No. 2017 to implement section 1 of this Act.
