A nonresident who is fifty-five yrs old or older may purchase a nonresident senior citizen small game hunting license and may hunt small game and waterfowl. The licensee is entitled to hunt statewide for the length of the applicable season. License cost is \$170.

By issuing this nonresident senior citizen license under this bill it will result in the department selling fewer licenses. NDGFD license revenue will decrease approx. \$32,810 for the biennium.

A nonresident small game or zoned waterfowl license is \$85 each. If 2 licenses are purchased the nonresident will breakeven ( $2 \times \$85 = \$170$ ). The negative revenue impact occurs when 3 or more licenses are purchased.

For 2010, there were 57 nonresidents (55 or older) who purchased 3 or more licenses totaling 193 licenses. If the bill was passed, it would result in a loss of NDGFD revenue of \$32,810/bien.
