Senate Bill 2282, as amended, ties the compensation amount for members of the State Water Commission and members of the Atmospheric Resource Board to the amount provided for members of the legislative management under section 54-35-10.

Both Water Commission and Atmospheric Resource Board members are currently compensated \$62.50 per day. This bill would change that amount to \$148.00 per day.

There are 7 compensated Water Commissioners who meet approximately 16 days per biennium for a total of 112 days. There are 7 compensated Atmospheric Resource Board members who meet approximately 5 days per biennium for a total of 35 days. The proposed increase from \$62.50 to \$148.00 is \$85.50 per day. 147 days multiplied by \$82.50 is \$12,127.50. \$12,127.50 plus a 10% payroll additive totals \$13,340 per biennium.
