

**SENATE BILL NO. 2275**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the office of management and budget for  
2 community service supervision grants; and to provide legislative intent.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY SERVICE SUPERVISION GRANTS -**

5 **FUNDING ALLOCATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the  
6 state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ~~\$500,000~~\$375,000, or so much of the  
7 sum as may be necessary, to the office of management and budget for the purpose of providing  
8 community service supervision grants, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending  
9 June 30, 2013. The office of management and budget shall distribute the grant funds on an  
10 annual basis on August first of each year of the 2011-13 biennium to North Dakota community  
11 corrections association regions as follows:
