- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to large capacity ammunition feeding devices; and to provide a penalty.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 62.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

6	Lar	<u>ge capacity ammunition feeding devices prohibited - Definition - Penalty.</u>
7	<u>1.</u>	A person may not sell, purchase, or possess a large capacity ammunition feeding
8		device manufactured after July 31, 2013. Under this section, "large capacity
9		ammunition feeding device" means a magazine belt drum feed strip or similar

- 10 device that has a capacity of, or that can be readily restored or converted to accept,
- 11 more than ten rounds of ammunition. The term does not include an attached tubular
- device designed to accept and capable of operating only with .22 caliber rimfire
   ammunition.
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer who possesses a large</u>
- 15 <u>capacity ammunition feeding device in connection with the officer's duties or to a</u>
- 16 <u>member of the armed forces of the United States or national guard, organized</u>
- 17 reserves, state defense forces, or state guard organizations who possesses a large
- 18 <u>capacity ammunition feeding device issued to the member by that organization and</u>
- 19 while on official duty.
- 20 <u>3.</u> <u>A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.</u>
