5 SECTION 1. Section 26.1-36-09.14 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

6 enacted as follows:

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26.1-36-09.14. Telemedicine reimbursement parity - Definitions.

8 1. As used in this section: 9 "Health care facility" means any office or institution at which health care services a. 10 or treatment of diseases are provided. The term includes hospitals; clinics; 11 ambulatory surgery centers; outpatient care facilities; nursing homes; nursing, 12 basic, long-term, or assisted living facilities; laboratories; and offices of any health 13 care provider. 14 b. "Health care provider" includes an individual licensed under chapter 43-05, 15 43-06, 43-12.1 as a registered nurse or as an advanced practice registered 16 nurse, 43-15, 43-17, 43-26.1, 43-28, 43-32, 43-37, 43-40, 43-41, 43-42, 43-44, 17 43-45, 43-47, 43-58, or 43-60. 18 "Policy" means a major medical expense policy, contract, or evidence of <u>C.</u> 19 coverage on a group, individual, blanket, franchise, or association basis. 20 d. "Store-and-forward technology" means electronic information, imaging, and 21 communication that is transferred, recorded, or otherwise stored in order to be 22 reviewed at a distant site at a later date by a health care provider or health care 23 facility without the patient present in real time. The term includes interactive 24 audio, video, and data communication.

10		(<u>(3)</u>	Does not include the use of audio-only telephone, email, or facsimile

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1 SECTION 2. Section 54-52.1-04.13 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

- 3 <u>54-52.1-04.13. Insurance reimbursement parity for telemedicine services.</u>
- 4 <u>The board shall provide medical benefits coverage under a contract for insurance pursuant</u>
- 5 to section 54-52.1-04 or under a self-insurance plan pursuant to section 54-52.1-04.2 which
- 6 provides reimbursement parity for telemedicine services in the same manner as provided under
- 7 <u>section 26.1-36-09.4.</u>
