- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-13-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to towing an individual on water skis or similar devices.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-13-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-13-10. Water skis and surfboard - Penalty.**

- No person<u>An individual</u> may <u>not</u> manipulate any water skis, surfboard, or similar
 device without wearing a life preserver approved by the department<u>, unless the</u>
 individual is sixteen years of age or older and engaged in windsurfing or boardsailing.
- No personAny time between one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise, an
 individual may not operate a vessel on any waters of this state towing a person or
 personsan individual on water skis, a surfboard, or similar device, nor may any person
 engage in water skiing, surfboarding, or similar activity at any time between the hours from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise.
- The provisions of subsections<u>Subsections</u> 1 and 2 do not apply to a performer
 engaged in a professional exhibition or a person<u>an individual</u> engaged in an activity
 authorized under section 20.1-13-11, and the provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to a person sixteen years of age or older engaged in windsurfing or boardsailing.
- No person<u>An individual may not</u> operate or manipulate any vessel, towrope, or other
 device by which the direction or location of water skis, a surfboard, or similar device
 may be affected or controlled in such a way as to cause the water skis, surfboard, or
 similar device, or any person thereonan individual on the same, to collide with or strike
 against any object or personindividual.

1	5.	No personAn individual may not operate a vessel on any waters of this state towing a-
2		person or personsan individual on water skis, a surfboard, or similar device unless
3		there is another personindividual in the towing vessel observing the person or-
4		personsindividual being towed or the vessel is not a personal watercraft and is
5		equipped with a mirror at least seventy-eight square inches [198.12 square
6		centimeters] that provides the operator an unobstructed wide field of vision to the
7		rear. However, this subsection does not apply to members of any organization
8		regularly staging water ski shows, tournaments, or exhibitions while engaged in the
9		performance of such <u>these</u> shows, tournaments, or exhibitions. The department shall
10		adopt rules <u>under section 20.1-13-11</u> to allow such <u>these</u> organizations to practice in
11		preparation for such <u>these</u> events , as prescribed in section 20.1-13-11 .
12	6.	Any personAn individual who violates this section is guilty of a class 2 noncriminal
13		offense.
