- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 30.1-32.1-12 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to transfer on death deeds.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 30.1-32.1-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **30.1-32.1-12.** Liability for creditor claims and statutory allowances.

- 7 1. To the extent the transferor's probate estate is insufficient to satisfy an allowed claim 8 against the estate or a statutory allowance to a surviving spouse or child, the estate 9 may enforce the liability against property transferred at the transferor's death by a 10 transfer on death deed. The estate may not enforce the liability against a purchaser of 11 the property for value or a person that acquires an encumbrance in the property for 12 value from the person that received the property by a transfer on death deed. 13 2. If more than one property is transferred by one or more transfer on death deeds, the
- 14 liability under subsection 1 is apportioned among the properties in proportion to
 15 theirthe net values of the property at the transferor's death.
- A proceeding to enforce the liability under this section mustmay not be commenced
 not later than eighteen months after the transferor's death. Any proceeding to enforce
- 18 the liability as to property that has been purchased or encumbered for value must be
- 19 brought against the person that received the property by a transfer on death deed for
- 20 <u>the net value at the time of the transferor's death.</u>
