1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 11-28.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to compensation of recreational service district board members.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 11-28.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **11-28.2-02. Meetings of recreation service districts - Election of board.**

7 The first meeting of the recreation service district must be held within thirty days after the
8 district is organized at a time and place designated by the board of county commissioners. At
9 the meeting, the qualified voters, as defined in section 11-28.2-03, shall elect not less than five
10 qualified voters of the district to serve as members of the board of recreation service district
11 commissioners. Each member elected and qualified shall serve until the first annual meeting of
12 the district. The voters of the district shall assemble and hold an annual meeting during the
13 month of June of each year, at a time and place within the county designated by the board of
14 recreation service district commissioners. In addition to the annual meeting, the board of
15 recreation service district commissioners may call a special meeting of the voters of the district
16 at the time and place the board selects. For any annual or special meeting, the board shall
17 publish notice of the meeting not less than fifteen days before the meeting in the official county
18 newspaper of the county in which the district is located and the notice must be mailed to
19 property owners of the district as recorded in the county treasurer's office in which the district is
20 located not less than fifteen days before the meeting. No fewer than five qualified voters of the
21 district must be elected to serve on the board of recreation service district commissioners at the
22 annual meeting. Each member elected shall serve a term of three years, until a successor is
23 elected and qualified. The term of each member must be established so that the terms of
24 approximately one-third of the members terminate each year. The members of the board are

- 1 entitled to receive compensation in an amount of no more than ~~twenty-five~~one hundred dollars
- 2 per meeting of the board, as determined by the board.
