1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 23-01.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to a medical director; and to provide an appropriation for the North Dakota trauma
3 system.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-01.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **23-01.2-04. Medical director.**

8 The state health officer ~~may~~shall appoint an emergency medical services and trauma
9 medical director to provide medical oversight and consultation in the development and
10 administration of the state emergency medical services and trauma systems. The medical
11 director must be a physician licensed in the state and must be contracted and paid by the state
12 department of health.

13 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
14 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ~~\$709,000~~\$240,000, or so
15 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of a
16 comprehensive state trauma system, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending
17 June 30, 2015, as follows:
