- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 and a new
- 2 subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to disabled
- 3 veterans and hunting fees; and to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the
- 4 North Dakota Century Code, relating to fishing fees for disabled veterans.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 created and enacted as follows:
- 8 "Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a one hundred percent
- 9 <u>service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or</u>
- 10 has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the
- 11 veteran's total disability ratio to one hundred percent as determined by the department
- 12 <u>of veterans' affairs.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota
- 14 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6. For a resident fishing license, ten dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years or
  over er, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran, the
  license fee is three dollars.
- SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
   created and enacted as follows:
- 20 For a resident disabled veteran combined general game, habitat stamp, small game,
  21 and fur-bearer license, three dollars.
