5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAROTA:
6	SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7	created and enacted as follows:
8	"Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a one hundred percent
9	service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or
10	has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the
11	veteran's total disability ratio to one hundred percent as determined by the department
12	of veterans' affairs.
13	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota
14	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
15	6. For a resident fishing license, ten dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years-
16	or over or, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran,
17	the license fee is three dollars.
18	SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
19	created and enacted as follows:
20	For a resident disabled veteran combined general game, habitat stamp, small game,
21	and fur-bearer license, three dollars.
