- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the feasibility and
- 2 desirability of providing assistance to obtain rural water for households with arsenic and other
- 3 harmful substances in the well water.
- 4 WHEREAS, water is essential for human life and production agriculture; and
- 5 WHEREAS, harmful substances in drinking water especially affect children; and

6 WHEREAS, there are wells that provide water to families in this state which have unsafe

- 7 levels of arsenic in the present water supply; and
- 8 **WHEREAS**, the federal government has stopped funding to provide rural water to those
- 9 households;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

11 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 12 That Legislative Management study the feasibility and desirability of providing assistance to
- 13 obtain rural water for households with arsenic and other harmful substances in the well water;
- 14 and
- 15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 17 the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly.
