1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
 4 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
 5 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
 6 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway  
 7 patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

18 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

19 **SIXTY-FOURTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time  
 20 funding items approved by the sixty-second legislative assembly for the 2011-13 biennium and  
 21 the 2013-15 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

9 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the  
10 2015-17 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of the  
11 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning  
12 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

13 **SECTION 3. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER.** The less estimated income line item in  
14 section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,841,066, or so much of the sum as may be  
15 necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the direction  
16 of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
17 highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

18 **SECTION 4. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS.** Each patrol officer of the  
19 state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an  
20 amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending  
21 June 30, 2015. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses,  
22 except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective  
23 home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are  
24 paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or  
25 other memorandums.
