## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 16.1-08.1-02 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 4. Even if the candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a candidate committee, or the candidate for legislative office has not received any contributions in excess of two hundred dollars during the reporting period, the candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a candidate committee, or the candidate for legislative office shall file a statement as required by this chapter. A statement filed according to this section by a candidate committee or, candidate for statewide office who does not have a candidate committee, or candidate for legislative office during the reporting period must show the following:
    - a. The gross total of all contributions received in excess of two hundred dollars;
    - b. The gross total of all contributions received of two hundred dollars, or less; and
    - c. The aggregated total of all expenditures in excess of two hundred dollars made to any person, the name of each such person, the mailing address of the person, the date of the most recent expense made to the person, and the purposes for which the aggregated expenditure total was disbursed to the person; and
    - <u>d.</u> The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting period.
