## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Display of Indian nation flags State capitol.</u>
- The official flag of each Indian nation in this state must be displayed prominently in
- 7 the chamber of the house of representatives, the chamber of the senate, and the courtroom of
- 8 the supreme court public corridors of the state capitol, as determined by the capitol grounds
- 9 planning commission.
- 10 **SECTION 2**.
- 11 <u>Display of service flags State capitol.</u>
- 12 The official flags of the United States prisoners of war and missing in action, army, navy,
- 13 marine corps, air force, coast guard, and national guard must be displayed prominently in the
- 14 chamber of the house of representatives, the chamber of the senate, and the courtroom of the
- 15 supreme court public corridors of the state capitol, as determined by the capitol grounds
- 16 planning commission.
