- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15.1-07-14 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to qualified electors for purposes of school district bond elections.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-07-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **15.1-07-14. Qualified elector.**

- 7 1. An individual who is a qualified elector of this state may:
- 8 a. Vote to elect board members for the school district in which the individual resides.
  - b. Serve as a board member for the school district in which the individual resides.
- 10 c. Serve as a judge or clerk of election for the school district in which the individual resides.
- d. Serve as the business manager of a school district.
- 2. For the purposes of elections held under this chapter, an individual residing on a
  military installation is deemed to be a resident of a school district if the school district
  admits students from the military installation pursuant to a contract and receives
  impact aid pursuant to Public Law No. 81-874 [64 Stat. 1100; 20 U.S.C. 236 et seq.],
  as amended.
- 3. For the purposes of an election on the question of approving bonds of a school district
   under chapter 21-03, a qualified elector includes any citizen of the United States who
   has attained the age of eighteen years and is a freeholder within the school district.
