- 3 agritourism within the property tax exemption for farm buildings; and to provide an effective

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Paragraph 2 of subdivision a of subsection 15 of section 7 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 8 "Farm buildings and improvements" includes a: 9 A greenhouse or other building used primarily for the growing of 10 horticultural or nursery products from seed, cuttings, or roots, if not 11 used on more than an occasional basis for a showroom for the retail 12 sale of horticultural or nursery products. A greenhouse or building 13 used primarily for display and sale of grown horticultural or nursery 14 products is not a farm building or improvement. 15 All or part of a building used in agritourism activity, as that term is <u>(b)</u> 16 defined in section 53-13-01. However, the owner is not required to 17 register as an agritourism operator under chapter 53-13 to qualify the 18 building as a farm building for purposes of this paragraph. 19 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after 20 December 31, 2014.
