## **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4024**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the degree of tax

2 collections volatility to which this state may be vulnerable and the feasibility of combining

3 existing funds or creating mechanisms to mitigate potential volatility of tax collections and state

4 budget impact.

5 WHEREAS, state budget decisions have become increasingly reliant on revenues from

- 6 energy taxes; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Pew Charitable trusts recently examined tax collection volatility among

8 states and concluded that North Dakota has the fourth highest degree of tax collections volatility

9 among the fifty states; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Legislative Assembly has had the foresight to establish various funds

11 before and during the recent boom cycle in oil and gas production in the state and consideration

12 should be given to contingency planning feasibility of consolidation and use of these funds to

13 mitigate the potential effects of substantial declines in tax collections;

## 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

15 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

16 That the Legislative Management study the degree of tax collections volatility to which this 17 state may be vulnerable and the feasibility of combining existing funds or creating mechanisms

18 to mitigate potential volatility of tax collections and state budget impact; and

- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 20 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 21 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
