

**Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota
In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 6, 2015**

HOUSE BILL NO. 1107
(Political Subdivisions Committee)
(At the request of the Adjutant General)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 37-17.3-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to public safety answering point service by the division of state radio; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-17.3-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

37-17.3-09. Public safety answering point service and fees.

The division may provide 911 primary public safety answering point services to a political subdivision ~~with that has~~ a population of fewer than ~~twenty thousand and twenty-five thousand at the time an agreement is signed for services with the division.~~ The division shall charge the apportioned amount consistent with the actual costs of providing the primary service per telephone access line and wireless access line ~~for 911 services provided to political subdivisions.~~ The fee for 911 wireless primary public safety answering point services must be charged to and paid by the political subdivision receiving services from the division under this section from and after the date of the agreement entered into by the political subdivision or its designee under section 57-40.6-05, ~~whether the date of that agreement is before or after April 4, 2003.~~ The division may provide primary public safety answering point services and other public safety answering point related services during emergencies and other times of need as agreed in a mutual aid agreement. Charges for services must be specified in the mutual aid agreement. Each ~~county~~ political subdivision currently receiving 911 primary public safety answering point services from the division shall abide by the standards established by law.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
