- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home;
- 2 to provide an exemption; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the veterans' home for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the veterans' home, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

8	2017-19 biennium. The veterans' home shall report to the appropriations committees of the			
9	sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning			
10	July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.			
11	SECTION 3. EXEMPTION - VETERANS' HOME CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING.			
12	The unexpended amount remaining from the appropriation for the veterans' home construction			
13	project in chapter 53 of the 2009 Session Laws which was continued into the 2011-13 biennium			
14	and the 2013-15 biennium under section 54-44.1-11 is not subject to the provisions of section			
15	54-44.1-11 at the end of the 2013-15 biennium and may be continued into the 2015-17			
16	biennium for paying expenses of the veterans' home construction project.			
17	SECTION 4. FUNDING TRANSFER - EXCEPTION - AUTHORIZATION. Notwithstanding			
18	section 54-16-04, the veterans' home may transfer up to \$84,500 from the operating expenses			
19	line item to the capital assets line item, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending			
20	June 30, 2015. The veterans' home shall notify the office of management and budget of any			
21	transfer made pursuant to this section.			
22	SECTION 5. SHOP ADDITION PROJECT. The veterans' home may use up to \$325,000			
23	from the Melvin Norgard memorial fund and up to \$463,200 from litigation proceeds or other			
24	funds for the cost of construction of a shop addition, which in total may not exceed \$788,200 for			
25	the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.			
26	SECTION 6. PHONE SYSTEM PROJECT FU	NDING. The veterans' home s	hall use up to	
27	\$48,000 of funding appropriated in the operating expenses line item in section 1 of this Act for a			
28	new home phone system for the veterans' home.			
29	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. Sections 4 and 5 of this Act are declared to be an emergency			
30	measure.
