1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for junior achievement grants.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$600,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of providing junior achievement grants, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
 - The superintendent of public instruction shall award annual grants under this section to four school districts that offer junior achievement programs at the elementary level, at the middle school level, and at the high school level.
 - 2 a. The amount of each grant is equal to the product of two hundred dollars multiplied by the total number of students participating in the district's junior achievement program.
 - b. If the amount appropriated is insufficient to meet the funding determination as set forth in this subsection, the superintendent of public instruction shall pro rate the grant based on the number of students from each district who participate in the program.
 - 3. The superintendent of public instruction may not expend more than \$300,000 under this section during the first year of the biennium.
