**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with Conference Committee Amendments  
ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1009**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state fair  
2 association; to provide for a legislative management study; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state fair association for the purpose of defraying  
7 the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending  
8 June 30, 2017, as follows:

14 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

15 **SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
16 items approved by the sixty-third legislative assembly for the 2013-15 biennium and the  
17 2015-17 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

19 Repair flood damage	\$2,750,000	\$0
20 Asphalt overlay project	<u>0</u>	<u>500,000</u>
21 Total general fund	\$2,750,000	\$500,000

22 The 2015-17 one-time funding amounts are not part of the entity's base budget for the 2017-19  
23 biennium. The state fair association shall report to the appropriations committees of the

1 sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning  
2 July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

3 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF**

4 **STATE PROPERTY.** During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider  
5 studying the maintenance and repair of state property and the source of funds to be used for  
6 maintenance and repair costs. The study must review current processes being used by state  
7 agencies to identify and address maintenance and repairs of state property and the  
8 appropriateness of the source of funds being used for these maintenance and repair projects.  
9 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any  
10 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly.

11 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** The capital assets line item in section 1 of this Act is declared  
12 to be an emergency measure.
