ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2010

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance
2 commissioner; to provide an appropriation for the distribution of funds from the insurance tax
3 distribution fund; and to amend and reenact section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century
4 Code, relating to the commissioner's salary.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
7 as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and other
8 income, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that
9 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

23 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance
24 tax distribution fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of

1 | ~~\$16,701,207~~\$16,481,207 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the insurance
2 | commissioner for the purpose of providing payments, in accordance with provisions of section
3 | 18-04-05, to North Dakota fire departments in the amount of \$15,681,207, and payments to the
4 | North Dakota firefighter's association in the amount of ~~\$1,020,000, of which, \$130,000 is one-~~
5 | ~~time funds~~\$800,000, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

6 | **SECTION 3. BONDING FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes \$50,813 from the state
7 | bonding fund to pay bonding fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 | 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

9 | **SECTION 4. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes \$1,660,748 from
10 | the state fire and tornado fund to pay fire and tornado fund administrative expenses, for the
11 | biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

12 | **SECTION 5. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes \$29,062
13 | from the state unsatisfied judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative
14 | expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

15 | **SECTION 6. PETROLEUM RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND.** Section 1 of this Act
16 | includes \$116,881 from the petroleum release compensation fund to pay petroleum release
17 | compensation fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and
18 | ending June 30, 2017.

19 | **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
20 | amended and reenacted as follows:

21 | **26.1-01-09. Salary of commissioner.**

22 | The annual salary of the commissioner is ~~ninety-six thousand seven hundred ninety-four-~~
23 | ~~dollars through June 30, 2014, and ninety-nine thousand six hundred ninety-eight~~one hundred
24 | two thousand six hundred eighty-nine dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred five
25 | thousand seven hundred seventy dollars thereafter.
