

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1012**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of  
2 human services; and to provide for exemptions.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the department of human services for the purpose of defraying the expenses  
8 of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as  
9 follows:

13       **SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFERS - EXCEPTION - AUTHORIZATION.** Notwithstanding  
14 section 54-16-04, the department of human services may transfer appropriation authority  
15 between line items within subdivisions 1, 2, and 3 of section 1 of this Act for the biennium  
16 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. The department of human services shall  
17 notify the office of management and budget and the legislative council of any transfer made  
18 pursuant to this section. The department shall report to the budget section after June 30, 2018,  
19 any transfer made in excess of \$50,000 and to the appropriations committees of the sixty-sixth  
20 legislative assembly regarding any transfers made pursuant to this section.

21       **SECTION 4. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated for the replacement of the medicaid  
22 management information system and related projects in chapter 50 of the 2007 Session Laws  
23 and chapter 38 of the 2011 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11.  
24 Any unexpended funds from these appropriations approved under section 54-44.1-11 for  
25 continuation into the 2009-11 biennium and then the 2011-13 biennium and then the 2013-15  
26 biennium and then the 2015-17 biennium are available for the completion of the medicaid  
27 management information system and related projects during the biennium beginning July 1,  
28 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

29       **SECTION 5. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated for the modification of the department  
30 of human services' eligibility systems in chapter 578 of the 2011 Special Session Session Laws  
31 is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from this

1 appropriation approved under section 54-44.1-11 for continuation into the 2013-15 biennium  
2 and then the 2015-17 biennium are available for the completion of the modification of the  
3 eligibility systems project during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30,  
4 2019.

5 **SECTION 6. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated for the development of the electronic  
6 health records system in chapter 12 of the 2013 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of  
7 section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from this appropriation approved under section  
8 54-44.1-11 for continuation into the 2015-17 biennium are available for the completion of the  
9 electronic health records system during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending  
10 June 30, 2019.
