## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1016

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the  
2 adjutant general; to provide a transfer; and to provide exemptions.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the office of the adjutant general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of  
8 the office of the adjutant general, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30,  
9 2019, as follows:

23 **SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE.** The appropriation in section 1 of this Act  
 24 includes the sum of \$638,219, of which \$253,000 is from the general fund, for increases in  
 25 employee health insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,249 per month.

26 **SECTION 3. ONE-TIME FUNDING.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
 27 items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted for the 2015-17 biennium:

16       **SECTION 4. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION.** In  
17 addition to the amount appropriated to the adjutant general in the veterans' cemetery line item  
18 in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional funds that are  
19 received and deposited in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund pursuant to sections  
20 37-03-14 and 39-04-10.10 for the operation of the North Dakota veterans' cemetery for the  
21 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

22       **SECTION 5. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS - TRANSFERS.** The adjutant general may  
23 transfer to the operating expenses and capital assets line items contained in section 1 of this  
24 Act up to the sum of \$500,000 from the various other line items contained in section 1 of this  
25 Act, as determined necessary by the adjutant general to provide for the maintenance and repair  
26 of state-owned armories in this state during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending  
27 June 30, 2019. Any amounts transferred pursuant to this section must be reported to the  
28 director of the office of management and budget.

29       **SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS**  
30 **FUND.** The estimated income line item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act includes

1 \$300,000 of one-time funding from the strategic investment and improvements fund for mobile  
2 repeaters and programming radios.

3 **SECTION 7. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the radio communications line item  
4 for the state radio tower package, in section 11 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws are not  
5 subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds are available for completing these  
6 projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

7 **SECTION 8. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and retention  
8 line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws is not subject to  
9 section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used to provide  
10 tuition assistance, recruiting, and retention incentives to eligible members of the North Dakota  
11 national guard during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

12 **SECTION 9. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and retention  
13 line item in section 15 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws is not subject to section  
14 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used to provide tuition  
15 assistance to eligible members of the North Dakota national guard, during the biennium  
16 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, contingent upon the adjutant general  
17 certifying to the office of management and budget that the national guard has received a new  
18 assignment in association with the Grand Forks air force base.

19 **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over pursuant to section 16 of chapter 50  
20 of the 2015 Session Laws which are unexpended as of June 30, 2017, are not subject to  
21 section 54-44.1-11 and are available for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any  
22 unexpended funds from this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust  
23 fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

24 **SECTION 11. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the grants line item in  
25 subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws for payment of adjusted  
26 compensation to veterans is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from  
27 this appropriation may be used for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any  
28 unexpended funds from this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust  
29 fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

30 **SECTION 12. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the radio communications line  
31 item for the state radio tower package pursuant to section 17 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session

1 Laws are not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds are available for completing  
2 these projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

3 **SECTION 13. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the disaster costs line for grants  
4 to political subdivisions for amounts required to match federal dollars on road grade raising  
5 projects and federal emergency relief funding pursuant to section 18 of chapter 50 of the 2015  
6 Session Laws which are unexpended as of June 30, 2017, are not subject to section  
7 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for these purposes  
8 during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

9 **SECTION 14. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for radio tower redundancy and  
10 next generation 911 in the radio communications line item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of  
11 chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws which are unexpended as of June 30, 2017, are not  
12 subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds are available for completing these  
13 projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
