1 A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to study the current juvenile  
2 justice process, levels of collaboration among various service systems, implementation of  
3 dispositional alternatives, and methods for improving outcomes for juveniles involved in the  
4 process.

5 **WHEREAS**, within the judicial branch, the juvenile court system is responsible for the  
6 adjudication and disposition of allegations that a juvenile is deprived, unruly, or has committed a  
7 delinquent act; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in addition to the juvenile court process, other entities are involved in  
9 addressing juvenile justice issues, including the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation  
10 through the Division of Juvenile Services, the Department of Human Services, regional human  
11 service centers, and a wide variety of treatment providers; and

12 **WHEREAS**, an effective resolution of juvenile justice issues must address recidivism,  
13 improve service access, efficiently use system resources, and collaborate with other service  
14 systems to identify the spectrum of needs of a juvenile involved in the system; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the current juvenile justice process has not been reviewed in almost thirty  
16 years; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the current process poses concerns for ensuring the most effective use of  
18 probation services, access to adequate support services, the potential for unwarranted  
19 institutional placements, and the need to distinguish between deprived juveniles and unruly and  
20 delinquent juveniles with respect to dispositions and service access.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**  
22 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

23 That the Legislative Management consider studying the current juvenile justice process, the  
24 appropriate age when a juvenile is considered capable of committing a criminal offense, levels
