- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15-10-12.4 of the of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to naming university and college buildings.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** Section 15-10-12.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - 15-10-12.4. Naming buildings.

When the state board of higher education or an institution under the control of the state board of higher education undertakes, or provides land for a capital construction project, including any new construction, renovation, or expansion, which costs more than ten million dollars, and more than one half of the cost is funded by state funds, approval from the legislative assembly must be obtained before the solicitation or receipt of any grant or loan greater than five million dollars which is given in exchange for naming rights to the building or any part of the building Authorization by either the legislative assembly or the budget section of the legislative management if the legislative assembly is not in session, is required before the acceptance of gifts, grants, donations, or bequests offered in exchange for naming rights to any state-owned building that has been funded all or in part by state general fund appropriations greater than five million dollars. This section does not apply to naming rights for individual rooms or gathering spaces.
