

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with Conference Committee Amendments  
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2011**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol;  
2 to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating  
3 to capitol building access cards; to amend and reenact subdivision j of subsection 3 of section  
4 39-12-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees for electronic permits; and to  
5 provide for a transfer.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
8 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
9 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
10 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
11 highway patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as  
12 follows:

21 **SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE.** Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of  
22 \$533,578, of which \$426,619 is from the general fund, for increases in employee health  
23 insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,241 per month.

1       **SECTION 3. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

2       **SIXTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
3 items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted for the 2015-17 biennium  
4 and the 2017-19 biennium one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of  
5 this Act:

15       The 2017-19 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget  
16 for the 2019-21 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of  
17 the sixty-sixth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium  
18 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

19       **SECTION 4. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER - HIGHWAY TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND.** The  
20 less estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,912,904, or so  
21 much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may  
22 be transferred at the direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of  
23 defraying the expenses of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017,  
24 and ending June 30, 2019.

25       **SECTION 5. MOTOR CARRIER ELECTRONIC PERMIT TRANSACTION FUND.** The  
26 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$1,369,165 from the motor carrier  
27 electronic permit transaction fund for the purpose of defraying various expenses associated with  
28 the issuance of permits and other nonenforcement motor carrier and administrative activities  
29 during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

30       **SECTION 6. STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND.** The estimated  
31 income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$358,000 of one-time funding from the strategic

1 investment and improvements fund for equipment replacement during the biennium beginning  
2 July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

3 **SECTION 7. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS.** Each patrol officer of the  
4 state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an  
5 amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and  
6 ending June 30, 2019. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other  
7 expenses, except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at the  
8 patrol officers' respective home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the  
9 same manner as salaries are paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without  
10 the presentation of receipts or other memorandums.

11 **SECTION 8.** A new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created  
12 and enacted as follows:

13 **Capitol building access card fund - Continuing appropriation.**

14 There is created in the state treasury a capitol building access card fund. The fund consists  
15 of any fees received by the superintendent for the issuance of capitol building access cards.  
16 The superintendent shall establish policies regarding the issuance of capitol building access  
17 cards and may charge a fee of ten dollars for each access card issued to an individual who is  
18 not an employee of the state of North Dakota. All moneys in the fund are appropriated to the  
19 highway patrol on a continuing basis for costs associated with the issuance of capitol building  
20 access cards and capitol complex security needs.

21 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision j of subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the North  
22 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

23 j. The highway patrol may establish an online electronic permit system. If the  
24 highway patrol establishes an online electronic permit system, the highway patrol  
25 shall assess an additional fee of up to fifteen dollar-fee~~dollars~~ for every permit  
26 issued under this section to be deposited into the motor carrier electronic permit  
27 transaction fund.
