A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the North Dakota
state university extension service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation
institute, main research center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to amend.
and reenact sections 4-05.1-05 and 4-08-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to main
research center experiment station and extension service position adjustments; and to provide
an exemption.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 9 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 10 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 11 other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops 12 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 13 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 14 North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great 15 plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and 16 agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as 17 follows: 18 Subdivision 1. 19 NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION SERVICE 20 Adjustments or 21 Base Level **Enhancements** Appropriation 22 Extension service \$52,517,908 \$0 \$52,517,908 23 -0-Soil conservation committee <u>1,133,362</u> 1,133,362

24	SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount			amount
25	included in the grand total other funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other			
26	income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other			
27	sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops			
28	institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch			
29	research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is			
30	appropriated for the purpose desig	gnated in the act, grant,	gift, or donation, for th	e biennium

31 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

1 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4-05.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 4-05.1-05. North Dakota state university main research center position adjustments -4 Budget section report. 5 The North Dakota state university main research center must be located on the campus of 6 North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science. The center is the administrative 7 location of the agricultural experiment station. The center shall conduct research and coordinate 8 all research activities of the agricultural experiment station. The research must have, as a 9 purpose, the development and dissemination of technology important to the production and 10 utilization of food, feed, fiber, and fuel from crop and livestock enterprises. The research must 11 provide for an enhancement of the quality of life, sustainability of production, and protection of 12 the environment. Subject to the availability of funds, the station director may adjust or increase 13 full-time equivalent positions in order to carry out activities to accomplish the mission of the 14 agricultural experiment station. Twelve-month employees whose employment is not limited in 15 duration must accrue leave pursuant to provisions of section 54-06-14. All full or partial 16 positions must be separate from North Dakota state university. Annually, the station director 17 shall report to the office of management and budget and to the budget section any adjustments 18 or increases made pursuant to this section. The center may conduct baseline research, 19 including production and processing in conjunction with the research and extension centers of 20 the state, regarding industrial hemp and other alternative industrial use crops. The center may 21 collect feral hemp seed stock and develop appropriate adapted strains of industrial hemp which 22 contain less than three-tenths of one percent tetrahydrocannabinol in the dried flowering tops. 23 The agriculture commissioner shall monitor the collection of feral hemp seed stock and 24 industrial hemp strain development and shall certify appropriate stocks for licensed commercial 25 cultivation. 26 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 4-08-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended 27 and reenacted as follows: 28 4-08-10. Extension agent to submit monthly account of expenditures - Position 29 adjustments - Budget section report. 30 The extension agent shall submit monthly an accurate itemized account of all expenditures 31 incurred by the agent in the regular conduct of duties to the North Dakota state university

1 extension service for examination and audit. When charges are made by an extension agent for 2 money expended in the performance of official duties, all items of one dollar or more expended 3 and charged for must be covered by a subvoucher or receipt that must be signed by the person 4 to whom the money was paid. The subvoucher or receipt must show at what place, on what 5 date, and for what the money expended was paid. The extension agent shall forward the 6 subvouchers or receipts with the bill, claim, account, or demand against the county. When 7 charges are made for transportation expenses, they may not exceed the amounts provided by 8 section 11-10-15, and must be in itemized form showing the mileage traveled, the days when 9 and how traveled, and the purpose thereof, verified by affidavit. The account must be 10 transmitted and recommended for payment by the North Dakota state university extension 11 service which shall audit the same and which may approve or disallow any expense item 12 therein. The state board of agricultural research and education and the president of North 13 Dakota state university shall control and administer the North Dakota state university extension 14 service subject to the supervision of the state board of higher education. Funds appropriated to 15 the North Dakota state university extension service may not be commingled with funds 16 appropriated to North Dakota state university. An appropriation request to defray expenses of 17 the North Dakota state university extension service must be separate from an appropriation 18 request to defray expenses of North Dakota state university. Subject to the availability of funds, 19 the director of the North Dakota state university extension service may adjust or increase 20 full-time equivalent positions in order to carry out activities to accomplish the mission of the 21 extension service. Twelve-month employees whose employment is not limited in duration must 22 accrue leave pursuant to provisions of section 54-06-14. All full- or part-time positions must be 23 separate from North Dakota state university. Annually, the director of the North Dakota state 24 university extension service shall report to the office of management and budget and to the 25 budget section any adjustments or increases made pursuant to this section. 26 **SECTION 6. DICKINSON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS**

INCOME. The Dickinson research extension center may spend up to \$755,000 of revenues
received during the 2017-19 biennium from mineral royalties, leases, or easements for ongoing
operational expenses. Any revenues received in excess of \$755,000 may be spent only for
one-time expenditures for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

1	SECTION 7. WILLISTON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS		
2	INCOME - REPORT. The Williston research extension center shall report to the sixty-sixth		
3	legislative assembly on amounts received and spent from mineral royalties, leases, or		
4	easements in the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and the		
5	biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
6	SECTION 8. TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Upon approval of the state board of agricultural		
7	research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the director of the		
8	main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of		
9	section 1 of this Act. Any amounts transferred must be reported to the director of the office of		
10	management and budget.		
11	SECTION 9. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The state board of		
12	higher education may adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities		
13	in section 1 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. All full-time or part-time positions must be		
14	separate from North Dakota state university. Annually, the board shall report to the office of		
15	management and budget and to the budget section any adjustments made pursuant to this		
16	section.		
17	SECTION 10. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND - EXCESS INCOME. Any unexpended		
18	general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in		
19	section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any		
20	unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended		
21	by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.		
22	SECTION 11. EXEMPTION. The amounts appropriated for the veterinary diagnostic		
23	laboratory and the seed cleaning plants contained in subdivision 4 of section 1 of chapter 20 of		
24	the 2015 Session Laws, are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any		
25	unexpended funds from these appropriations or related revenues are available and may be		
26	expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
