- 2 victims treatment and support services; and to provide for reports to the attorney general,
- 3 legislative assembly, and legislative management.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - REPORTS TO ATTORNEY GENERAL, LEGISLATIVE
6	ASSEMBLY, AND LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT. There is appropriated out of any moneys in
7	the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000, or so
8	much of the sum as may be necessary, to the attorney general for the purpose of providing
9	grants to organizations involved in providing prevention and treatment services related to
10	human trafficking victims for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
11	The attorney general may provide grants for the development and implementation of direct care
12	emergency or long-term crisis services, residential care, training for law enforcement, support of
13	advocacy services, and programs promoting positive outcomes for victims. Any organization
14	that receives a grant under this section shall report to the attorney general on the use of the
15	funds received and the outcomes of its program. The attorney general shall report to the
16	legislative management during the 2017-18 interim and to the appropriations committees of the
17	sixty-sixth legislative assembly on the status and results of the grant program.
