- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 62.1-01-01 and subsection 1 of
- 2 section 62.1-02-05 relating to the possession of firearms or weapons in government buildings.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 62.1-01-01 of the North Dakota

- 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 5. "Government building" means a building <u>or a portion of a building</u> which is owned,
- 7 possessed, or used by or leased to the state of North Dakota, or any of its political
- 8 subdivisions and in which access is not permitted unless an individual passes through
- 9 equipment that detects weapons and is staffed by armed security personnel.
- 10 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 62.1-02-05 of the North Dakota
- 11 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 1. An individual who knowingly possesses a firearm or dangerous weapon at a public
- 13 gathering is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. For the purpose of this section, "public
- 14 gathering" means an athletic or sporting event, a school, a church, and a <del>publicly</del>
- 15 owned or operatedgovernment building.
