- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying the 2 estimated fiscal impact to the state of refracturing existing oil wells. 3 WHEREAS, total statewide oil production exceeded four hundred eighteen million barrels in 4 fiscal year 2016; and 5 WHEREAS, the state provides tax incentives related to other energy resources to promote 6 economic development; and 7 WHEREAS, research by the Energy and Environmental Research Center indicated a small 8 increase in the percentage of oil recovered can result in billions of barrels of additional oil 9 production: 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 11
  - NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
  - That the Legislative Management consider studying the estimated fiscal impact to the state of refracturing existing oil wells, including the estimated costs and benefits related to tax collections and any potential tax incentives for refracturing existing oil wells based on an oil extraction tax exemption on the first one hundred thousand barrels of incremental oil production from a refractured oil well; and
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and 18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 19 the Sixty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
