## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1302

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 32-15 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the sale of property acquired by eminent domain or acquired when the
- 3 property was eligible for taking by eminent domain, but no longer needed for a public purpose.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 32-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Sale of property not used for original purpose.
- 8 Except as otherwise provided by law, if property is acquired by the state or a political
- 9 <u>subdivision through eminent domain but not used for the purpose for which it was acquired, the</u>
- 10 person from whom it was acquired must be given an opportunity to purchase the property. The
- 11 purchase price must equal the just compensation paid for the property minus any attorney's
- 12 fees and court costs the purchaser incurs in the new transaction or incurred challenging the
- original acquisition. If the opportunity to purchase the property is declined, the property must be
- sold at auction, and the mineral rights, if acquired through eminent domain for the same
- 15 purpose, must revert to the person from whom the rights were acquired.
