BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER. There is appropriated out of
5	any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
6	\$450,000\subseteq 150,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, and from special funds that
7	must be transferred by the state fair association from its operating fund to the state historical
8	society, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state
9	historical society for the purpose of providing a grant to an entity to relocate the pioneer village
10	from the North Dakota state fairgrounds to another location within Ward County, for the
11	biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The funds appropriated in this
12	section may be transferred and spent only upon certification by the director of the state
13	historical society to the director of the office of management and budget that all pioneer village
14	buildings located on the North Dakota state fairgrounds which are required to be removed to
15	satisfy the court ruling have been removed by June 15, 2019.
