- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to patriotic society's access to students during school hours.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

## 6 Patriotic society - Access to school and students.

- For purposes of this section, "patriotic society" means a youth group listed under
  title 36, United States Code, subtitle II, part b.
- 9 <u>2.</u> <u>The principal of a public school shall allow a representative of a patriotic society, during</u>
- 10 regular school hours and on school premises, to present information and recruit
- 11 <u>students to participate in the patriotic society. Before a representative of a patriotic</u>
- 12 society may speak with students at a public school, the representative shall notify the
- 13 principal of the representative's intent to schedule a date and time to present
- 14 information to students. The principal shall respond promptly to the request and
- 15 <u>coordinate with the representative to schedule the appearance.</u>
- A principal may allow a patriotic society to use school premises to allow students to
  participate in activities provided by the patriotic society at a time other than during
  regular school hours.
