- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study on the capturing of gas and the
- 2 long-term benefits of capturing gas on the state's revenue stream.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY CAPTURING OF GAS. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying solutions to the capturing of gas and the long-term benefits of capturing gas on the state's revenue stream. The study
- 7 must include an overview and an evaluation of public policies within states, the federal
- 8 government, tribal nations, and foreign governments aimed at increasing the capture of gas.
- 9 The study must include consideration of the economic impact and long-term benefits
- 10 from the capture of gas on the state and the desirability and feasibility of implementing methods
- or mechanisms to capture all gas, maximize profits, ensure efficient use, and minimize
- 12 environmental impacts from the capturing of gas. The legislative management shall report its
- 13 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
- 14 recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly.
