- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-10-15.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to intern embalmer applications and qualifications; and to declare an emergency.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-10-15.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 43-10-15.4. Intern embalmer Application Qualifications.
- The board shall issue a certificate of registration as an intern embalmer to each
  applicant who files an application upon a form and in a manner the board prescribes,
  accompanied by a fee not to exceed fifty dollars, and who furnishes sufficient evidence
  - to the board that the applicant:

- 11 <u>1. a.</u> Is at least eighteen years of age;
- 12 2. b. Is of good moral character; and
- 3. <u>c.</u> Has completed an accredited four-year high school course of study and one year
   of accredited college or university studies;
- 15 <u>d. Has completed one year of accredited college or university studies; and</u>
- 16 <u>e. Has been accepted to attend or is enrolled in an accredited college of mortuary</u>
   science, or has graduated from an accredited college of mortuary science.
- 18 <u>2. An intern embalmer may not practice for more than six months before attending an accredited college of mortuary science.</u>
- **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
